In return for the use today and on all future days of property, facilities and services of the Manager/Instructor the Rider, his heirs and legal representatives, hereby expressly agree to the following:

1. Rider is responsible for full and complete insurance coverage on his horse, personal property and himself.
2. Rider understands there are risks in and around equine activities and that an equine activity sponsor and or equine professional manager/instructor is NOT liable for an injury to, or death of a rider and/or participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities.
3. RIDER AGREES TO ASSUME ANY AND ALL RISKS INVOLVED IN OR ARISING FROM RIDER'S USE OF OR PRESENCE UPON MANAGER/INSTRUCTOR'S PROPERTY AND FACILITIES including, without limitation but not limited to: risk of death, bodily injury, property damage, falls, kicks, bites, collisions with vehicles, horses or stationary objects, fire or explosion, the unavailability of emergency medical care and/or the negligence and/or deliberate act of another person.
4. Rider agrees to hold Manager/Instructor and all successors and assigns, subsidiaries, franchises, affiliates, officers, directors, employees, agents completely harmless and not liable and releases them from all liability and AGREES NOT TO SUE on account of or in connection with any claims, causes of action, injuries, damages, costs or expenses arising out of Rider's use of or presence upon manager/Instructor's property and facilities, including without limitation, those based in death, bodily injury, property damage, including consequential Damages, except if damages are caused by direct, willful and wanton gross negligence of the Manager/Instructor.
5. Rider agrees to waive the protection afforded by any statute or law in ANY jurisdiction (e.g. California Civil Code 1542) whose purpose, substance and/or effect is to provide that a general release shall not extend to claims, material or otherwise, which the person giving the release does not know or suspect to exist at the time of executing the release.
6. Rider agrees to indemnify and defend Manager/Instructor against, and hold harmless from, any and all claims, causes of action, damages, judgments, cost or expenses, including attorney's fees, which in any way arises from Rider's use of or presence upon the Manger's/Instructor's property and facilities.
7. Rider agrees to abide by all of Manager/Instructor's rules and regulations, and Rider is responsible for using protective gear, i.e., Safety Helmet/Hard Hat and Boots.
8. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, Camp Leaping Horn/or the official event photographer, Paws and Rewind LLC. may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the event for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the event, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

This contract is non-assignable and not transferable and is made in and entered into in the State of South Carolina and shall be enforced and interpreted under the laws of this state. Should any clause be in conflict with State Law, then that clause only is null and void. When Manager/Instructor and Rider (and Rider's Parent or Guardian, if Rider is a minor) signs this contract, it will then be binding on both parties, subject to the above terms and conditions.
